When

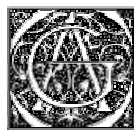
July 6 – 24; Extended day opportunities are available from 9am – 3pm.

Daily tutorials - \$100 / week
Extended Morning (9am – noon): students will have opportunities to work on computer programs, play outside, and work on small interest-based projects – additional \$35 / week; Extended Afternoon (noon – 3pm); students may join Highlander Charter School students for City Arts programming - additional \$10 / week.
